◆ NANOCODE WORKSHOP (Industrial Session)

The objective of NanoCode project is to define and develop a framework aimed at supporting the successful integration and implementation, at European level and beyond, of the Code of Conduct (CoC) for nanosciences and nanotechnologies (N&N) research as developed by the European Commission.

The CoC collects together most of the concepts and values that have emerged in recent years from the debate on the governance and ethics of nanotechnologies, and is an important reference point concerning the principles that should underpin research activities, the interaction amongst key stakeholders and, in general, "good governance" for the responsible development of nanotechnologies.

The consultation process and the debate on the draft of the Master Plan will take place during this workshop involving in the first place a small number of active stakeholders identified in previous phases of the project.
